As PokerStars relaunched in Michigan the following year, his efforts accelerated and, by the end of 2024, Kaye had left his job as a data analyst to play poker full-time. By the time 2024 had ended, Kaye was representing PokerStars as a member of Team Pro. On joining PokerStars Team Pro, David said, "The process has been amazing. The thing that really impressed me was that PokerStars wasn't trying to make me sell myself to them. Instead, it was them telling me how much they really liked what I did. The fact they were very clear and clearly appreciated and respected what I do, I mean obviously coming from PokerStars that was just very cool." David's Twitch streams mainly focus on No-Limit Hold'em cash games, and his friendly community attracts many players from the same US cash game pools as he plays in. As online poker grows in the USA, Kaye is committed to being an ambassador to the game, and to creating an enriching community for new players to enter into.
